MEETINGS

- → <u>04th February, 2013</u> a Project Steering Committee (PSC) meeting under Punjab-Irrigated Agriculture Productivity Improvement Project (PIPIP) was held at Committee Room of Agriculture Department, Lahore under the chairmanship of the Secretary Agriculture to considered work plan for C-1 & D-3 components of the scheme.
- → <u>28th February, 2013</u> to review and discuss on cross cutting issues i.e., procurement, financial management, and environmental and social safeguards of the World Bank's and DFID ongoing / pipeline projects a meeting with heads of World Bank & DIFID was held in the Committee Room No. 1 of P & D Department under the chairmanship of Chairman Planning and Development Board.

TRAININGS

→ From 30th January, 2013 to 12th February, 2013, two (2) weeks training course of WMO (OFWM) on Drip and Sprinkler Irrigation Design was conducted at WMTI. Already installed sites were also visited during the class session.



→ From 18th February, 2013 to 2nd March, 2013 Two (2) weeks training course of WMO (OFWM) on Drip and Sprinkler Irrigation Design was conducted at WMTI, to meet crucial and top priority training needs in the field of water management. The professional trainings are mandatory for the staff engaged in the various schemes being implemented under the water management wing.

- → In February 2013, Four (4) training courses for "Laser Tractor Operation", at Lahore, were conducted by Water Management Training Institute. The participants were given detailed lectures on operation and maintenance of LASER Units. Practical field training for laser unit operation was also imparted to the participants. Each trainee physically worked on the tractor with LASER Units for at least one hour per day. Participants of the trainings were the tractor drivers or farmers who have received LASER Units with subsidy from the Department under PIPIP.
- → <u>In February 2013</u>, twenty (20) field days were celebrated at all three regions i.e., Multan (4), Lahore (12) and, Rawalpindi (4) by the WMTI, Lahore to impart instruction and guidance at the farmer's doorstep. The technical and logistic support was provided by the WMTI for organizing such sessions.
- → <u>16th February, 2013</u> a World Bank team comprising of Mr. John Henry Stin, Director Sustainable Development, South Asia, and Mr. Masood Ahmad, Task Team Leader visited Sargodha. Mr. John Henry Stin inaugurated watercourse No. 32835/L Chak No. 33-SB and



watercourse No. 25215/L Chak No. 33-SB and attended the field day conducted in the said village. The staff of OFWM including DPD (PIPIP), RPD (Rawalpindi), and District Officer (OFWM), Sargodha explained to the farmers about benefits of watercourse improvement, laser land leveling, and high efficiency irrigation schemes.

Furthermore, a physical demonstration of laser land leveling was organized at the site later on the team also visited drip irrigation scheme installed on the land of Mr. Sohail Abbas Warich, Sargodha.
