

Request for bids

1. The Agriculture Department, Government of the Punjab has received a loan amount equivalent to US\$ 130 million from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) towards the cost of Additional Financing for “**PUNJAB IRRIGATED-AGRICULTURE PRODUCTIVITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**”. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for “*Installation of Automated Solar Coupled Drip Irrigation System*” on 5 acres at Water Management Research Farm, Renla Khurd, Okara.

2. The *DIRECTOR, WATER MANAGEMENT TRAINING INSTITUTE, PUNJAB, LAHORE* invites sealed bids from already prequalified firms of OFWM for installation of Automated Solar Coupled Drip Irrigation System. The detail is as under:

6. Bids must be submitted on or before 11:00 AM on 20-01-2020 and must be accompanied by a bid security *RS. 50,000/- (which is less than 5 % of estimated cost) IN THE FORM OF BANKERS CHEQUE OR BANK CALL DEPOSIT IN FAVOUR OF THE DIRECTOR, WATER MANAGEMENT TRAINING INSTITUTE, PUNJAB, LAHORE*.

7. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 11:30 AM on 20-01-2020 in the Committee Room of Directorate General Agriculture (Water Management) Punjab, 21-Davis Road, Lahore.

8. The bidders are requested to give their best and final prices as no negotiations are expected.

9. The bidders are required to submit the bid in the single stage-two envelope procedure.

10. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.

11. The deduction, at source, of all relevant taxes at the prescribed rates is applicable.
